# How to add a headrest

# Tool required:

Phillips screwdriver

#### Step 1

Feel in the general direction of the two headrest T-nuts, as shown in the diagram to the right.

Note: All measurements are taken from the edge of the back cap, not the foam.

# Step 2

Use a Phillips head screwdriver to create two holes in fabric. Stop when screwdriver hits the T-nut.

Do not worry about the quality of the holes created on the fabric, the T-nut does not need to be visible.

Holes will be completely covered by the headrest brackets.

### Step 3

Align the newly created holes with the holes in the headrest brackets. Install the two M6x25mm pan head fasteners provided, securing the headrest to the back of the chair.
